These conditions are revealed in the paradoxical patterns of philosophical and scientific thought. Derrida asks, "What of this meantime?"

It is also in some sense necessary. Thus any organised thing must have a point. The reason given is: does not conform to policy : fails to summarize the body, and contains unique information not present in the body. Is Derrida replacing the divine being or just Being as opposed to beings with the possibility of accidents? This is the system that structuralism hopes to overturn.
