Only a few weeks after leaving office in Burr embarked on a tour of the region beyond the The Burr Conspiracies mountains, beginning in Kentucky and eventually reaching as far south as New Orleans. Believing that an accurate account of the conspiracy was still needed decades after the event, he worked to record and publicize aspects of it that might otherwise be lost. In effect, the constitution now recognised the existence of parties, or at least party tickets.
