Juxtaglomerular JG cells: Renin-secreting cells that are in contact with the macula densa and the afferent arterioles of the renal nephron. Muscles in the ureter walls continually tighten and relax forcing urine downward, away from the kidneys.

The kidneys are bean-shaped, reddish brown paired organs, concave on one side. Because the urethra is so much shorter in a woman it makes it much easier for a woman to get harmful bacteria in her bladder this is commonly called a bladder infection or a UTI. The brain signals the bladder muscle to tighten, which squeezes urine out of the bladder. A rare infection of the ureter, can also occur with cystitis.
